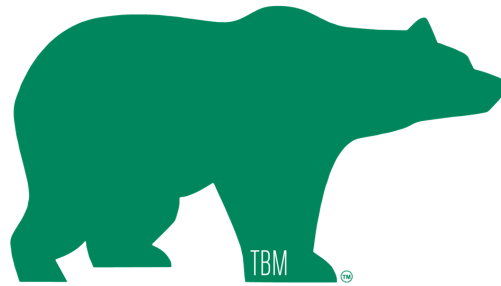


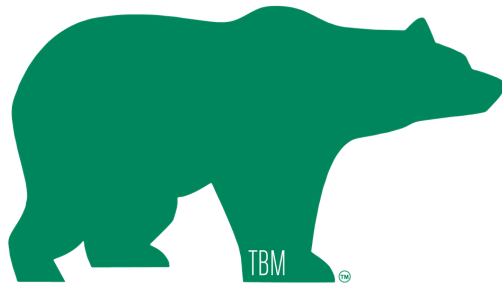
TOSS

KEEP

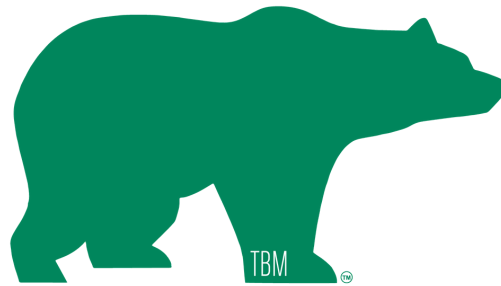

IF NOT, CHECK YOUR CITY'S RECYCLING GUIDELINES.

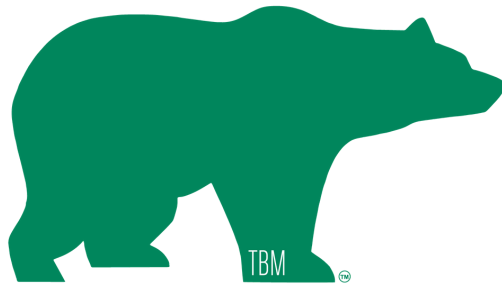
